THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY GROUP'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE POST-HEARING COMMENTS

NOW COMES the ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY GROUP ("IERG"), by and through its attorney, Antonette R. Palumbo, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.522, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant this Motion for Extension of Time to File Post-Hearing Comments for an additional one weeks until December 16, 2016, or such time as deemed proper by the Board.

IERG is an Illinois not-for-profit affiliated with the Illinois Chamber of Commerce.

IERG consists of 48 member companies in a variety of major industries throughout the State of Illinois that are regulated by governmental agencies that promulgate, enforce, or administer environmental laws, rules, or regulations. One of IERG's primary roles is to represent the interests of its members in rulemakings before the Board. Several of IERG's members will seek permits-by-rule ("PBR") as allowed by the regulations proposed in this proceeding.

The Board held hearings on this matter on October 26, and November 16, 2016. At the October 26 hearing, IERG questioned Agency representatives about the tuning requirements in the proposed PBR rule at Section 201.630. *See* Oct. 26 Tr. at 37-38. Specifically, IERG asked how the boiler tuning requirements for PBR aligned with tuning requirements in federal rules, such as NESHAP. *Id.* at 37, 40. The representatives from the Illinois EPA noted that requirements set forth in the proposed PBR regulations are slightly different than the NESHAP

requirements and are verbatim the NO_x RACT tuning requirements. *Id.* The NO_x RACT

requirements are Illinois regulations.

IERG members who take advantage of a PBR for small boilers could potentially be

subject to tuning requirements pursuant to the PBR rules, NO_x RACT (35 Ill. Adm. Code

217.166), and/or NESHAP (40 CFR Part 63 DDDDD). IERG believes that any promulgated

regulation should seek to harmonize the tuning requirements, including the frequency and

training requirements of the various applicable rules in order to ensure the rule is comprehensive

and can be easily utilized while minimizing duplicative or unnecessary regulatory burdens.

IERG is working with the Illinois EPA on drafting modified language for Section 201.630.

As such, IERG respectfully requests the Board grant this Motion for Extension of Time

to allow IERG and the Agency to finalize a revised proposal that would harmonize the federal

and state requirements for boiler tuning.

WHEREFORE, the ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY GROUP moves

the Illinois Pollution Control Board grant this Motion for Extension of Time to File Post-Hearing

Comments for an additional one weeks until December 16, 2016, or such time as deemed proper

by the Board.
