


# PUBLISHER'S CERTIFICATE

NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE  
The Attorney General has brought a case against Rain CII Carbon LLC, (formerly known as Robinson Carbon, Inc.), a foreign limited liability company for violation of State pollution control rules. On January 10, 2017, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with the State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person desiring that a hearing be held may demand a public hearing in this case by filing a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice. The hearing request should refer People of the State of Illinois v. Rain CII Carbon LLC, (formerly known as Robinson Carbon, Inc.), a foreign limited liability company, PCB 04-137 and should be mailed to the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
