- 4. Whether the rule or rulemaking creates a new mandate or expands an existing mandate.

The Department's prompt attention to this matter is appreciated, as such information should be received by the Committee prior to the commencement of the second notice period for this rulemaking. The first notice period expires on 3/26/17. For your convenience, we have enclosed a copy of the text of the rulemaking.
