ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On February 22, 2017, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Modern Drop Forge Company, LLC (petitioner) may appeal a January 13, 2017 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The joint notice was timely filed because it was postmarked on or before the filing deadline. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). The Agency determined that it could not approve billings for site investigation activities without an approved budget for petitioner's leaking underground storage tank located at 13810 South Western Avenue in Blue Island, Cook County.

The Board extends the appeal period until May 22, 2017, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
