ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.M. Keenan):

On April 7, 2017, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Illinois Ayers Oil Company (petitioner) may appeal a March 16, 2017 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination concerning petitioner's property located at 141 South Congress in Rushville, Schuyler County, the Agency rejected the Free Product Removal Plan submitted by petitioner on the grounds that other remediation options must be explored.

The Board extends the appeal period until July 23, 2017, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
