ORDER OF THE BOARD (by K. Papadimitriu):

On April 13, 2017, Ron Bright filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns his request to declassify special waste, miscellaneous fill, located at the Clouse Quarry (Site No. 1798095009) in Tazewell County. Mr. Bright petitioned the Board to review the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's January 21, 2016 determination, denying his request.

Mr. Bright's motion states that the parties resolved the matter. Motion at 1. The Agency's response, filed on April 20, 2017, states that it has no objection to the motion. The response also notes that the material has been removed from the site to a nearby landfill for proper disposal under Mr. Bright's "Non-Special Waste Certification." Response at 1. The Certification provides that Section 22.48(a) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/22.48(a) (2016)) has been satisfied. *Id*.

The Board grants the motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
