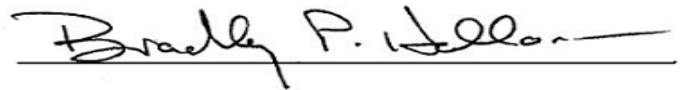

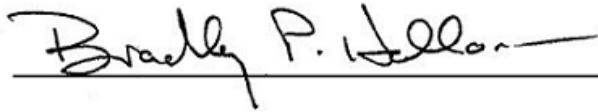
1. Quantify, in feet, the maximum feasible alternative setback between the injection locations and Municipal Water Supply Well #2 and Emergency Backup Well #1.
