Respondent to provide any additional exhibits that they intend to offer regarding their respective witnesses, along with their position on authentication of complainants proposed exhibits for each witness on or before October 13, 2017;

Complainants are to respond with their position on authentication of respondent's exhibits on or before October 18, 2017.

The parties are directed to file all of the above-mentioned documents with the Board and served on the hearing officer on the specified dates.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on September 21, 2017, at 11:00 a.m. The telephonic status

conference must be initiated by the complainants, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.
