JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Macon County Environmental Management Department, a delegated county of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

- That Respondent, Matthew Lawrence, is the land operator of a property located at 11622 N. Kenney Road, Warrensburg in Macon County, Illinois.
- That Respondent has owned and/or operated said property at all times pertinent hereto.
- That on November 16, 2017, Laurie Rasmus of the Macon County Environmental
 Management Department inspected the above-referenced facility. A copy of her

inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Laurie Rasmus during the course of her inspection of the above-referenced facility, the Macon County Environmental Management Department has determined that Respondent violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1); and
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3); and
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris as defined in Section 3.160(a), a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than January 30, 2018, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1, and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation(s) as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Macon County Environmental Management Department and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00).

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation(s) as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- (1) Macon County Environmental Management Department and mailed to Macon County Environmental Management Department, 141 South Main Street, Room 408, Decatur, Illinois 62523.
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Along with payments, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms to ensure proper documentation of payments.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be

assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Macon County State's Attorney may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Macon County State's Attorney at 253 East Wood Street, Decatur, Illinois 62523. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Inspection Report Narrative

This site was inspected on November 16, 2017 between 10:35 a.m. and 11:15 a.m. by Laurie Rasmus (author of this report) with Nick Burge, both of the Macon County Environmental Management Department (MCEMD). Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were mostly clear skies and a temperature near thirty-seven degrees Fahrenheit with light winds. Twenty-four photographs were recorded. No samples were collected. No other persons were observed on-site.

General Information/Site History/Property Ownership

This rural, residential property is addressed as 11622 N. Kenney Road in the Township of Austin in Macon County, Illinois. According to the Macon County Assessor's records, the property is owned by Edwin D. Lawrence Sr. but a public official reported that Matthew Lawrence resides on the property.

Previously, this property was inspected on September 22, 2004, resulting in the issuance of an Administrative Citation Warning Notice to Mary Lawrence and Luke Landers on October 14, 2004 in regards to apparent violations for open burning.

More recently, an inspection was conducted on September 18, 2017 in response to a report of open burning. Apparent violations were observed during this inspection, resulting in the issuance of an Administrative Citation Warning Notice to Matthew Lawrence on September 27, 2017. No response has been received from Mr. Lawrence as of the writing of this report.

This inspection on November 16, 2017 was conducted to determine compliance with the Act and Regulations.

Inspection Findings

While driving by the property, I observed that the south section of property east of the sheds but west of the field's west margin appeared to have apparent violations in regards to open dumping and open burning. So as to first try to make contact with Matthew Lawrence, I continued to drive north and parked in the driveway of the property's residence. I sounded my vehicle's horn and then walked to the south door of the house with Mr. Burge in accompaniment. I saw that the storm door was ajar and that the main door was partially open. I closed the storm door and then knocked but did not receive a response. Mr. Burge and I then returned to the vehicle and I drove to the south section of the property where open dumping and open burning were apparent.

Mr. Burge waited in the vehicle while I proceeded to walk the area while making observations and recording photographs and geographic data.

I observed an area east of the sheds but west of the west margin of the field, which was approximately 60 feet east-west by 150 feet north south that appeared to be a burn site for construction and demolition debris, off-site generated landscape waste and other waste items (photos 01 – 04, 06 – 16, 22 - 24). The area had patches of scorched earth with remnants of blackened vegetation in the marginal areas of the patches. Waste items that were observed on the ground in these areas included what appeared to be rusted tire beads from tires that had been burned (photo 03), charred and uncharred dimensional lumber, numerous rusty nails, debris that appeared to be burned drywall board, vinyl siding of which some appeared to be partially melted and charred, rusty hardware, ash, fines, charred and uncharred landscape waste that appeared to be generated from off-site, charred and uncharred bricks and brick pieces, charred and uncharred pieces of concrete, food packaging and what appeared to be charred remnants of fiber glass of the type that is used for insulation.

Along the west margin of the apparent burn site, various waste items appeared to be open dumped on the ground (photo 21). Waste items observed included a television set (photo 05) and a cash register (photos 18, 19). Accumulations of landscape waste, which appeared to be off-site generated, were also on the ground in this area. Containers, such as buckets, contained waste items that appeared to be disposed of including rusty cans and various metal parts of which some appeared to be charred and/or rusted (photo 20). Other containers in the area, all of which appeared to be empty, included a red, plastic container of the type used for gasoline, a five-gallon bucket labeled as "hydraulic oil", and a hinged box (photo 17).

Following my observations, I returned to my vehicle, concluded the inspection and drove from the property with Mr. Burge.

Summary of Apparent Violations

The following violations, which were observed during the initial inspection on September 18, 2017, were once again observed along with new violations regarding tires.

Environmental Protection Act 415 ILCS 5/1 et seq. (formerly III Rev. Stat. Ch. 111 ½, 1001 et seq.) {hereinafter referred to as the "Act"} and **35 Illinois Administrative Code**. (Title 35: Environmental Protection, Subtitle G: Land Pollution, Chapter I: Pollution Control Board) [Regulations]

Pursuant to Section 9(a) of the Act, no person shall cause, threaten, or allow; or tend to cause, threaten or allow, air pollution in Illinois.

A violation of Section 9(a) is alleged because evidence of open-burning that would cause, threaten, or allow; or tend to cause, threaten, or allow air pollution in the State of Illinois was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 9(c) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow the open burning of any refuse, conduct any salvage operation by open burning or cause or allow the burning of any refuse in any chamber not specifically designed for the purpose and not approved by the agency.

A violation of Section 9(c) is alleged because evidence that open burning of refuse occurred on site was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 21(a) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste.

A violation of Section 21(a) is alleged because evidence of open dumping of waste was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the Act, in relevant part, no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit granted by the Agency or in violation of any conditions imposed by such permit, including periodic reports and full access to adequate records and the inspection of facilities, as may be necessary to assure compliance with this Act and with regulations and standards adopted there under.

A violation of Section 21(d)(1) is alleged because evidence that waste was disposed of and/or stored without a permit granted by the Agency was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the Act, no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 21(d)(2) is alleged because evidence that waste was disposed of and/or stored in a way that violates regulations and standards adopted by the Board was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the Act, no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards there under.

A violation of Section 21(e) is alleged because evidence that waste was disposed of and/or stored in a manner that does not meet the requirements of the Act was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in any of the following occurrences at the dump site...litter.

A violation of Section 21(p)(1) is alleged because evidence that open dumping of waste was caused or allowed to occur and resulted in litter deposition on site was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in any of the following occurrences at the dump site...open burning.

A violation of Section 21(p)(3) is alleged because evidence that open dumping of waste was caused or allowed to occur and resulted in open burning on site was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in any of the following occurrences at the dump site...clean construction and/or demolition debris as defined in Section 3.160(b) of this Act.

A violation of Section 21(p)(7) is alleged because evidence that the open dumping of waste was caused or allowed to occur and resulted in the deposition of clean construction and/or demolition debris on site was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 55(a), (1) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow open dumping of any used or waste tire.

A violation of Section 55(a), (1) is alleged because evidence that waste tires were open-dumped on the site was observed during the inspection.

Pursuant to Section 55(a), (2) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow open burning of any used or waste tire.

A violation of Section 55(a), (2) is alleged because evidence that waste tires were open-burned on the site was observed during the inspection.
