ORDER OF THE BOARD (by K. Papadimitriou):

On December 12, 2017, Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (ISTHA) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns a leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at Tri-State Tollway (I-294), northbound at mile post 1.1, in South Holland, Cook County. ISTHA appeals Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's September 3, 2003 determination, which approved, with modifications, ISTHA's high priority corrective action plan for the leaking UST site. In its November 16, 2017 order, the Hearing Officer noted that during the November 16, 2017 telephonic status conference ISTHA stated that a No Further Remediation Letter has been issued. The Board grants ISTHA's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
