ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE
The Attorney General has brought a case against Bodycote Thermal Processing, Inc., a Delaware corporation, for violating state pollution control rules.
