Dear Clerk of the Board Brown,

I encourage the Illinois Pollution Control Board (IPCB) to approve the revision to Illinois' Multi-Pollutant Standard air emissions rule filed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). I support this revision as it is the best path forward to preserve air quality, while protecting jobs and sustaining economic vitality in the state of Illinois. The IEPA estimates that allowable annual emissions of SO₂ would be 17% lower than under the current rule, while NO_x emissions would be 24% lower. All other federal and state air quality regulations, including health-based standards under the National Ambient Air Quality Standards, will remain unchanged and in place.
