10	is also part of Governor's Rauner's Executive
11	Order 2016-13 initiative aimed at reducing
12	regulatory burden and clarifying regulations in
13	Illinois. Amendments proposed in this rulemaking
14	concern parts, as I mentioned, 900, 901, 902 and
15	910 of the board's noise rules.
16	They update definitions,
17	references and sound measurement procedures. They
18	also clarify language in some sections and remove
19	provisions that are no longer applicable or
20	necessary. The board adopted proposed amendments
21	for public comment in this proceeding on October
22	5, 2017, without submitting it to first-notice
23	publication. The board invited comments and
24	scheduled two hearings on the proposal by video

5 The second hearing is scheduled on February 21st and the board published notice of 6 7 those hearings in the State Journal-Register of 8 Springfield on December 7th, 2017, and in the 9 Chicago Tribune on December 8th, 2017. The board 10 invited interested persons to pre-file their 11 comments and testimonies and to contact the 12 Hearing Officer to be added to this docket's 13 notice list. So far, the board has not received 14 any comments in this rulemaking. We have not 15 received any pre-filed questions, any pre-filed 16 testimonies. No appearances were filed either. 17 This hearing will be dedicated 18 to any testimony or public comments that any 19 member of the public wish to provide at this 20 specific hearing. It is also dedicated to the 21 comments that will satisfy obligations under 22 Section 27(b) of the Environmental Protection Act. 23 It requires the Department of Commerce and 24 Economic Opportunity, DCEO, to provide -- to
