## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On January 10, 2018, Cedar Concepts Corporation filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal (Mot.), which concerns a July 8, 2014 determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. That determination denied Cedar Concepts' application for a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) for its manufacturing facility located at 4342 South Wolcott Avenue in Chicago, Cook County.

Cedar Concepts states that IEPA has issued a FESOP that resolves all issues raised by the petition. Mot. at 1. Cedar Concepts requests that the Board dismiss the appeal and close the docket. Counsel for IEPA reported to counsel for Cedar Concepts that IEPA does not object to the motion. *Id.* The Board grants Cedar Concepts' motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
