NOTICE OF HEARING

The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearings regarding rule changes proposed by the Board on October 19, 2017. **In The Matter of: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 225.233, Multi-Pollutant Standards (MPS), R18-20.** If adopted by the Board, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) intends to submit any rules adopted by the Board in this rule-making to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for review and approval as a revision to the Illinois Regional Haze State Implementation Plan (SIP) to address the visibility protection requirements for Federal Class 1 under the federal Clean Air Act. See 42 U.S.C. § 7491. The revisions submitted to USEPA will include not only amendments to current regulatory provisions proposed by IEPA but also newly created provisions, along with an analysis demonstrating that the amended rules do not interfere with attainment or maintenance of any applicable National Ambient Air Quality Standard, reasonable requirement of the federal Clean Air Act. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings and to submit written comments. The Public Hearings will be held on April 16, 2018, at 4:00 pm at the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 N Grand Ave E, North Entrance, off Converse Street, Springfield, Illinois; to be continued if necessary on April 17, 2018, at 11:00 am. The hearings are subject to cancellation without notice and may be confirmed by calling the Office of the Clerk at 312/814-3461.
