PUBLIC NOTICE

On April 12, 2018, Southern Illinois Power Cooperative filed a Petition for Alternative Thermal Effluent Standards with the Illinois Pollution Control Board (PCB #18-75). SIPC is seeking alternative thermal effluent limitations for its Marion Generating Station located in Williamson and Johnson Counties, near Marion, Illinois, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.141(c), Section 316(a) of the Clean Water Act, and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 106, Subpart K. Marion Generating Station produces electricity. As part of the electric generating process SIPC draws water from Lake of Egypt, uses the water to cool the steam used to generate electricity, cools the heated water, and discharges it back into Lake of Egypt. Specifically SIPC seeks the following limits: In lieu of the temperature water quality standards defined by Section 302.211, the thermal discharge to Lake of Egypt from SIPC's Marion Generating Station shall not exceed the following maximum temperatures, measured at the outside edge of the 26-acre mixing zone in Lake of Egypt, by more than 1 percent of the hours in a 12-month period ending in any month: 72°F from December through March; 90°F from April through May; 101°F from June through September; and 91°F from October through November.

SIPC is located at 13543 Lake of Egypt Road, Marion, IL 62959. Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the proceeding, as found in this notice, and must be filed with the Clerk, Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601 20826476; 4/15/18
