Since this proposal was first introduced, Dynegy merged with Texas-based Vistra Energy and created an energy goliath worth billions of dollars. This is clearly not a company on the verge of collapse and in need of a bailout of any kind! The company's motivation for seeking the proposed rule change through the Illinois EPA is solely to maximize its profits. Why should this out-of-state company get a pollution bailout that puts corporate profits over air quality in Illinois?

The Pollution Control Board must reject this dangerous proposal and stand up for clean air in Illinois, not more corporate profits.
