**CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE ORDER**

This cause coming on to be heard on status, the parties having appeared and having agreed to the following schedule, and the Board Hearing Officer having been otherwise duly advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's response to Complainant's Motion to Strike Respondent's Affirmative Defenses is due by July 27, 2018;
2. Complainant's reply in Support of its Motion to Strike Respondent's Affirmative Defenses is due by August 10, 2018;
3. The parties shall issue written discovery requests on or before July 13, 2018;
4. Responses to the issued written discovery requests shall be due on August 31, 2018;
5. All written discovery shall be completed by September 14, 2018, subject to the parties' ongoing duty to supplement their respective responses;
6. Depositions of all parties and non-opinion witnesses shall be completed by October 31, 2018;
7. Expert reports of all opinion witnesses shall be served by December 3, 2018 and depositions of all opinion witnesses shall be completed by December 28, 2018;
8. All discovery shall be closed by December 31, 2018;
9. All dispositive motions shall be filed by January 31, 2019.

10. The parties agree that communications between (a) the Illinois Attorney General's Office and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, and (b) Respondent and its outside counsel, regarding this matter are deemed attorney-client privileged, need not be produced and do not need to be included in a privilege log.
