"The redevelopment project shall be completed, and all obligations issued to finance redevelopment costs shall be retired. no later than December 31 of the year in which the payment to the City treasurer as provided in the Act is to be made with respect to ad valorem taxes levied in the twenty-third calendar year following the year in which the ordinance approving the 71st & Stony Island RPA was adopted." #1066652
