This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/31.1, formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, Ch. 111 ½, par. 1031.1, and delegated to the County of LaSalle pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/4 (r), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 111 ½, par. 1004 (r).

FACTS

- 1. That Respondent, Jeffrey Schuster, is the present owner and/or operator of property located in Dimmick Township, LaSalle County, Illinois.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit, and is designated with Site Code No. 0998295005. Said facility is commonly known to the Agency as the Schuster Property
- 3. That the Respondent has owned and/or operated said facility since April 26, 2013.
- 4. That on August 10, 2018, Brian Gift, Director, LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Land Use, under the authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the above described facility. A copy of the inspection reports setting forth the results of such inspections are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. On the basis of direct observations of Brian Gift of the LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Land Use, it has been determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner which results in the following occurrences:

That on August 10, 2018, an on-site inspection of said facility disclosed the following:

CIVIL PENALTY

- 6. Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42 (b) (4), formerly III. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1042 (b) (4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for each violation specified above in Paragraph 5(b) for a total of three Thousand Dollars (\$3000.00). Additionally, should Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violation alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollar (\$1500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.
- 7. If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than thirty-five (35) days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board of review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against you shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.
- 8. When payment is made, one check should be made payable to the LASALLE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AND LAND USE and mailed to:

Also, please complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form, along with your payment, to assure proper documentation of payment.

9. If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest from such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after the adjudicatory hearing is not paid when due, the LaSalle County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest and hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover their costs of litigation.

GENERAL REMARKS

Brian Gift representing the LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Land Use under the delegated authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency at the property of Jeff Schuster performed an open dump inspection on June 10, 2018. The property is located at 290 N. 35th Road, Dimmick Township, LaSalle, Illinois.

Weather conditions noted on arrival were overcast and approximately 80 degrees with wind NE 8 mph.

The inspection began at 0936. I arrived at the site and pulled off the south side of N 35th road, adjacent to the north side of the property. Looking south, I observed large accumulations of pallets, garbage bags, etc... intermingled with the trees on the site. I also observed some sort of encampment with lawn chairs set up. I walked west to view the west side of the site and observed pallets, garbage bags, buckets, junk, etc... lining the entire west side of the property. Moving toward the east side of the property, I viewed an inoperable vehicle filled with garbage and surrounded by garbage. Behind the vehicle and along the entire east side of the property, I observed more pallets, garbage bags, and additional junk.




