#### FIRST NOTICE COMMENTS OF THE ILLINOIS ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE

The Illinois Attorney General's Office ("IAGO"), on behalf of the People of the State of Illinois, hereby submit the following first notice comments to the Illinois Pollution Control Board (the "Board") for its consideration in the above-referenced matter.

- 1. On August 3, 2017, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (the "Illinois EPA") filed a procedural rulemaking proposing that the Board amend its public water supplies rules by adopting a new Part 604 entitled "Design, Operation and Maintenance Criteria" and amending Parts 601, 602, 607 and 611. The People appreciate the efforts of the Illinois EPA and the Board to amend the public water supplies rules.
  - 2. The IAGO's comments are as follows:
    - a. Section 601.101(b)(3) The Illinois EPA should consider including "lead" as one of the constituents given concerns about lead in drinking water.
    - b. Section 602.245(d)(2) Recommend clarifying the use of "the flood or record".
    - c. Section 604.105(b) Add the word "the" before "requirements".
    - d. Section 604.515 In the first sentence, change "purpose" to "purposes".
    - e. Section 604.1140(d)(7) How "near" must the residential or developed areas be to trigger this requirement? What "provisions" must be made?

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- f. Section 604.1335(a)(2) Delete the first word "to", so as to start with "ensure".
- g. Section 604.1440(b)(1)(D)(ii) Change the punctuation at the end of the sentence from a period to a semi-colon.
- h. Section 604.1510(a)(2) Add the word "the" before "date of the most recent test".
- i. Section 604.1510(c) The short-form "CCCDI" is used for "cross-connection control device inspector" before this subsection.
- j. Section 611.350(k) Add "a" before "SEP" therein.
- k. Section 611.381(c)(2)(B) Is the reference to ", by an SEP," correct?

WHEREFORE, the IAGO respectfully requests that the foregoing first notice comments be considered.
