JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq., specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

1. The Respondent, Bruce Reese, is the present owner and in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois.

2. The Respondent, Bryan Bruce, is in control and possession and an occupant of a facility located in the County of Jackson, Illinois.

3. The facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code # 077 801 5043. The facility is known to the Agency as the Carbondale/Bruce Reese site.

4. The Respondents have owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.

5. On September 27, 2018, Deborah Johnson, Environmental Compliance Inspector, Jackson County Health Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms. Johnson's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by

reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

Based on her direct observation she has determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on September 27, 2018, an inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

The Respondents have caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).

2. The Respondents have caused or allowed the deposition of general or clean construction or demolition debris at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than November 15, 2018, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1, and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory

civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- County of Jackson, c/o Jackson County Treasurer, Jackson County Courthouse, Murphsyboro, Illinois 62966; and
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may either initiate proceedings against either or both Respondents in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

You have the right to contest this Citation, pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If you elect to contest this Citation, you must file a Petition For Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition For Review shall also be filed with Daniel Brenner, Assistant State's Attorney, Jackson County Courthouse, Third Floor, Murphysboro, Il 62966. <u>YOUR PETITION FOR REVIEW MUST BE FILED WITHIN 35 DAYS OF THE DATE OF SERVICE OF THE PRESENT CITATION ON YOU. YOUR PETITION MUST STATE THE REASON(S) YOU BELIEVE THE PRESENT MATTER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED. IF YOU FAIL TO FILE YOUR PETITION AND STATE THE REASONS THE PRESENT MATER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED, A DEFAULT ORDER AGAINST YOU WILL BE ENTERED BY THE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.</u>

Background Information

This site was initially inspected pursuant to a complaint in 2012. Subsequent to the complaint investigation, two Administrative Citation Warning Notices (ACWN) and, in 2017, an Administrative Citation (AC) were issued to the property owner and site operator. The AC was eventually withdrawn by the county due to substantial compliance efforts by the owner and/or operator, and the understanding that the county would monitor the site for continued compliance.

This site is still owned by Bruce Reese, 2042 Dillinger Road, Carbondale, Illinois 62901 Attachment: Pages 1&2). This address is his mailing address and not the address listed on the attachment. Bryan Bruce lives on the property in a mobile home and the site address is 2186 Dillinger, Carbondale, Illinois 62901.

General Remarks

I conducted an inspection of the property on September 27, 2018. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were: overcast with low winds and an air temperature of approximately 59°F. All photos taken during the inspection are identified on the attached site sketch.

As I was driving towards the property, I observed what appeared to be open dumped waste scattered throughout the site. I parked the vehicle at the east end of the site and I observed from this location an area of open dumped waste (Photos 1 & 2).

I began my inspection and walked towards the front door of the mobile home. I knocked and Tabitha Nix, Bryan Bruce's daughter, came to the door and decided to accompany me throughout the inspection.

Following is a partial list of the types of open dumped waste or in some cases specific items, I observed at this site, by photo groups:

Photos 1 – 4, eastern end of property: wooden pallets, demolition and/or construction debris, household trash, used/waste tires, plastic containers and other plastic items, lawn chair, aluminum cans, toys, various metal items, a rolled-up tarpaulin, dimensional

lumber, a wheelbarrow, coolers, radio/cassette player, furniture, various equipment, and items not readily identifiable.

- Photos 5 9, surrounding the mobile home: various equipment, furniture, a plastic bucket and other plastic items, metal items, fishing poles, loose and bags of household waste, a table umbrella, a deteriorating hot tub filled with metal and plastic items, demolition and/or construction debris and items not readily identifiable.
- **Photos 10**, in and surrounding the old burn area/fire ring: a recliner, a propane cylinder, a table, a bicycle, wooden pallet and a plastic tote filled with unknown material.
- Photos 11 13, western side of property: an abandoned motorhome, a waste pile overgrown with vegetation, various metal and plastic items, demolition and/or construction debris, a chiminea fireplace, a folder chair, and other items not readily identifiable.

There have been several field visits and telephone conversations to inform the respondents of the site's return to non-compliance. During this inspection, I observed little progress towards the clean-up of the site and observed additional open dumping of waste.

At the time of the inspection, the items listed above were not in use, were not usable in their current condition and were not stored in such a way as to protect for any future use. Also, at the time of the inspection, the items were unorganized and stored in an unsightly manner. The total volume of waste observed was approximately 60 cubic yards.

After some discussion with Ms. Nix, I ended my inspection at 1:33 p.m.

Violations Observed:

(21)(a): Cause or allow open dumping; (21)(p): Cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in any of the following occurrences at the dump site: (1) Litter; (5) Proliferation of disease vectors; and (7) Deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction or demolition debris: During the inspection, the open dumping of waste that resulted in litter, disease vectors, and the deposition of general construction or demolition or demolition debris was observed.

(21)(d)(1): Conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation: Without a permit: : At the time of the inspection, the Jackson County Health Department (Health Department) had not received documentation from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) that the site owner/operator had been issued a permit to conduct a wastestorage, waste-treatment or waste-disposal operation.

(21)(d)(2): In violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board: During the inspection, violations of regulations or standards adopted by the Board regarding the operation of a waste-storage, waste-treatment or waste-disposal site were observed. During the inspection,

the open dumping of waste that resulted in litter was observed.

(21)(e): Dispose, treat, store, or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into the State at/to sites not meeting requirements of the Act or the 35 Illinois Administrative Code (IAC): At the time of the inspection, this site did not meet the Act or regulatory requirements regarding the disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment or transport of waste into Illinois.

(55)(a)(1): No person shall: Cause or allow open dumping of any used or waste tire: At the time of the inspection used/waste tires that had been open dumped were observed.

(55)(a)(3): No person shall: Cause or allow storage of any used tire unless the tire is altered, reprocessed, converted, covered, or otherwise prevented from accumulating water: At the time of the inspection used/waste tires that had not been prevented from accumulating water were observed


