RE: Rulemaking – Air R18-20 Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 225.233, Multi-Pollutant Standards

To the Illinois Pollution Control Board:

On behalf of the Central Illinois Healthy Community Alliance (CIHCA), I am requesting that the Illinois Pollution Control Board have the next public hearing for case R18-20 in Peoria. Our group is concerned about the health impacts of the Dynegy-Vistra fleet on the residents of our community. We are particularly troubled by the potential for further degradation of our air quality under a revised MPS for Dynegy-Vistra plants in the Peoria area (Duck Creek and E. D. Edwards).

CIHCA urges the Illinois Pollution Control Board to schedule the public hearing here in Peoria, starting in the early evening, perhaps 6:00 p.m., to allow an opportunity for many local residents to address their concerns to the Board. The Peoria Public Library has been a convenient, central location for past hearings. Please plan to have microphones available to ensure all speakers are heard. We ask that the hearing be scheduled for early 2019 so as to avoid overlapping with many competing activities during the holiday season.
