JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2016).

FACTS

- That Dean Kibler is the present owner of a property located 101 N. Monroe Street, St. Joseph,
 Champaign County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection
 Agency as St. Joseph/Kibler, Dean.
- That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection
 Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0190905027.
 - 3. That Respondent has operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on October 11, 2018, Curt White of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Champaign Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Curt White during the course of his October 11, 2018 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that the Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2016).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2016).
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of waste in standing or flowing waters, a violation of Section 21(p)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(4) (2016).
- (4) That Respondent caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2016).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2016), Respondent is jointly and severally subject to civil penalties of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalties specified above shall be due and payable no later than January 14, 2019, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2016), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2016), if Respondent fails to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2016). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Executive Summary

I reinspected this site on October 11, 2018. The weather conditions during the inspection were sunny and 48° F. No interviews were conducted during the inspection. The initial inspection was conducted as a result of a citizen complaint #213. Apparent violations were again observed.

This site is located at 101 N. Monroe St, St. Joseph, IL 61873, property ID No. 28-22-14-102-005. The owner of the property is Dean Kibler. The mailing address for Mr. Kibler is the same as the location. The ownership was determined by going to the Champaign County Supervisor of Assessments Office in Urbana, IL.

This inspection was conducted in accordance with Sections 4(c) and (d) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"). The purpose of this inspection was to determine if the site is in compliance with the solid waste provisions of the Environmental Protection Act and regulations, as well as any solid waste permits the Illinois EPA has issued to the facility.

Evaluation Narrative

I arrived on the property at 7:50 am. There is a residence at the site. Nobody was present. I proceeded to the area previously inspected on May 17, 2018. I observed used tires and other litter in flowing water behind the residence (see photo 1). I observed a waste/burn pile that included wood, plastic, ash, and other litter (see photos 2 & 5). It appears more waste is being brought to the site. I observed furniture, televisions, computer monitors, wire and other litter scattered around the site (see photos 3, 4 & 6). I observed an estimated 20 used tires scattered around the site (see photos 7 & 9). I inspected the used tires for water accumulation and mosquito larvae. I observed water accumulation (see photo 8) and mosquito larvae. These used tires and other material at the site were being dumped haphazardly in weeds, not stored in such a way as to protect any future use and being kept unsightly and in an unsanitary manner. I left the site at 8:20 am.




