MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER QUESTIONS

NOW COMES Southern Illinois Power Cooperative (SIPC), by and through its attorneys, Schiff Hardin LLP, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500 and 101.522, requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board) Hearing Officer, Bradley Halloran, grant SIPC additional time to file responses to the Board's questions. In support of this motion, SIPC states:

- 1. On April 12, 2018, SIPC filed a petition for an alternative thermal effluent limitation with the Board.
- 2. On June 21, 2018, the Board accepted SIPC's petition for hearing and stated it may submit questions to SIPC through a hearing officer order.
- 3. On December 7, 2018, Hearing Officer Halloran issued an order attaching 32 questions regarding SIPC's petition and supporting appendices.
- 4. SIPC is diligently evaluating the questions, but requests more time, given holiday schedules and the availability of experts, to prepare the information requested in the

Board's December 7, 2018 questions. For example, one expert is currently unavailable for medical reasons to answer questions related to the petition.

5. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has no objection to SIPC's motion for extension of time to file answers to the Board's December 7, 2018 questions.

WHEREFORE, SIPC requests a 30-day extension to file answers, or until February 6,

2019.
