Petitioner, Shelby County Energy Center, LLC, by and through its attorneys, Sidley

Austin LLP, hereby moves the Illinois Pollution Control Board (the Board) to dismiss this action.

In support of its motion, Petitioner states as follows:

- 1. On October 29, 2014, Petitioner (through predecessor and former petitioner NRG Wholesale Generation LP) filed a Petition for Review of CAAPP Permit and Motion for Stay requesting review of the Clean Air Act Permit Program ("CAAPP") permit I.D. No. 173801AAA issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Agency") on September 26, 2014 (the "CAAPP Permit").
- 2. On November 6, 2014 and November 20, 2014, the Board entered orders accepting the Petition for hearing and granting the Petitioner's request for stay of the contested permit conditions, respectively.
- 3. Subsequently, SCEC and the Agency have engaged in negotiations regarding the CAAPP Permit and resolved the issues raised in the Petition. Pursuant to these negotiations, SCEC submitted an application to modify the CAAPP Permit and the Agency issued a revised permit to SCEC on September 20, 2018.

- 4. SCEC requests that the Board dismiss this matter and close the docket.
- 5. Counsel for the Agency does not object to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner, Shelby County Energy Center, LLC, requests that the Board dismiss this action and close the docket.
