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MOTION FOR VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL

Petitioner, Aurora Generation, LLC, by and through its attorneys, Sidley Austin LLP, hereby moves the Illinois Pollution Control Board (the Board) to dismiss this action. In support of its motion, Petitioner states as follows:

1. On October 29, 2014, Petitioner (through predecessor and former petitioner NRG Wholesale Generation LP) filed a Petition for Review of CAAPP Permit and Motion for Stay requesting review of the Clean Air Act Permit Program (“CAAPP”) permit I.D. No. 043407AAF issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (“Agency”) on September 25, 2014 (the “CAAPP Permit”).
2. On November 6, 2014 and November 20, 2014, the Board entered orders accepting the Petition for hearing and granting the Petitioner’s request for stay of the contested permit conditions, respectively.
3. Subsequently, Aurora Generation, LLC and the Agency have engaged in negotiations regarding the CAAPP Permit and resolved the issues raised in the Petition. Pursuant to these negotiations, Petitioner submitted an application to modify the CAAPP Permit and the Agency issued a revised permit to Aurora Generation, LLC on November 16, 2018.
