

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.K. Carter):

On October 29, 2014, Rockford Power, LLC and Rockford Power II, LLC (collectively, Rockford), f/k/a NRG Rockford LLC and NRG Rockford II LLC, petitioned the Board for review of certain conditions in a Clean Air Act Program Permit (CAAPP). The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) issued the permit for Rockford's Energy Center located at 136 Harrison Avenue in Rockford, Winnebago County. On January 16, 2019, Rockford filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss its appeal. In its motion, Rockford stated that the parties have resolved the issues raised in its petition, and the Agency issued a revised permit. The Board grants Rockford's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
