ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On January 16, 2019, Shelby County Energy Center, LLC (SCEC), filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss (Mot.) this appeal. The appeal concerns a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) for SCEC's natural gas-fired power plant at 3575 E. 400 North Road, in Neoga, Shelby County. The Board entered orders on November 6, 2014 and November 20, 2014 accepting the petition for hearing and granting a request for stay of the contested conditions, respectively. SCEC's motion to voluntarily dismiss explains that the issues raised in the petition are resolved. SCEC's motion also notes that the Agency does not object to the motion. Mot. at 2. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
