RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

On April 5, 1984 the United States Environmental Protection Agency published notice (49 Fed. Reg. 13646) of the adoption of the following amendment to the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS):

Subpart HHH - Standards of Performance for Synthetic Fiber Production Facilities - 40 CFR Part 60, (35 Ill. Adm. Code 230.700).

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Board is required to adopt amendments "in substance identical" to the federal new source performance standard amendments. The Board will do so through incorporation by reference of the federal amendments as peremptory rules. The Board will also update the Code of Federal Regulations citation to the 1983 edition (which includes all NSPS amendments prior to July 1, 1983) and delete all references to amendments based upon federal NSPS amendments adopted prior to July 1, 1983.

ORDER

The Board hereby adopts the following amendments to Title 35: Environmental Protection; Subtitle B: Air Pollution; Chapter I: Pollution Control Board; Subchapter e: Peremptory Rules; Part 230: New Source Performance Standards.

SUBPART HHH: SYNTHETIC FIBER PRODUCTION FACILITIES

Section 230.700 Synthetic Fiber Production Facilities

The Board incorporates by reference 40 CFR 60, Subpart HHH (1983), as amended at 49 Fed. Reg. 13646, April 5, 1984.
