
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon a February 3, 1987 petition for variance filed by Honeywell, Inc. seeking relief from the open burning of explosive waste provision of the Board's air pollution regulations. The Board requests that Petitioner submit such an affidavit in support of its petition.
