RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

This matter comes before the Board upon an April 17, 1985 publication of notice (50 Fed. Reg. 15386) by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) of the promulgation of a standard for Radon-222 emissions from underground uranium mines to air under the National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP):

Subpart B - National Emission Standard
for Radon-222 Emissions from Underground
Uranium Mines § 40 CFR 61
(35 Ill. Adm. Code 231.122)

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Environmental Protection Act, the Board is required to adopt amendments "in substance identical" to the federal NESHAP amendments. The Board will do so through incorporation by reference of the federal amendments as peremptory amendments.

ORDER

The Board hereby adopts the following amendment to Title 35: Environmental Protection; Subtitle B: Air Pollution; Chapter I: Pollution Control Board; Part 231: Hazardous Air Pollutants:

SUBPART B: RADON-222 EMISSIONS FROM
UNDERGROUND URANIUM MINES

Section 231.122 Radon-222 Emissions from Underground
Uranium Mines

The Board incorporates by reference 40 CFR 61, Subpart B as adopted at 50 Fed. Reg. 15386, April 17, 1985.
