ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):


This petition, filed April 18, 1985 and requesting variance from the fecal coliform effluent water quality standard formerly contained in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.209 (cf. the Board's Order in R77-12, Docket D, May 2, 1985), is deficient in the following respects:

- 1) The denomination of the parties was incorrect; further pleadings should contain the caption as above;
- 2) Exhibit A referred to in paragraph 3 was not submitted;
- 3) No information was submitted as the fecal coliform count in the discharge absent disinfection; and
- 4) The petition does not contain a compliance plan, even by way of the filing of a petition for site specific rule.

If an amended petition curing these deficiencies is not filed within 45 days of the date of this Order, this petition will be subject to dismissal.
