**06-141** Flagg Creek Water Reclamation District v. Village of Hinsdale, Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago, Illinois Department of Transportation, and DuPage County – No action taken.

**06-142** Magie Bros./Penreco v. IEPA – The Board ordered petitioner to file an amended petition to cure noted deficiencies, accompanied by an attorney’s appearance on or before April 10, 2006, or the petition would be subject to dismissal.

**06-143** People of the State of Illinois v. Astec Mobile Screens, Inc. – The Board accepted for hearing this Resource Conservation and Recovery Act enforcement action involving a site located in Whiteside County.

**06-144** People of the State of Illinois v. Golden Bag Company – The Board accepted for hearing this air enforcement action involving a site located in Kane County.

**06-145** Arlyn D. Fisk d/b/a Arlyn Fisk’s Service Center v. IEPA – The Board accepted for hearing this underground storage tank appeal involving a Randolph County facility.

**06-146** Midwest Generation, L.L.C., Waukegan Generating Station v. IEPA – The Board accepted for hearing this permit appeal involving a Lake County facility.

**AC 06-027** County of LaSalle v. Jerry Koetz – The Board accepted an administrative citation against this LaSalle County respondent.

**AC 06-028** County of Macon, Illinois v. Onyx Valley View Landfill – The Board accepted an administrative citation against this Macon County respondent.

**R06-025** In the Matter of: Proposed New 35 Ill. Adm. Code 225 Control of Emissions from Large Combustion Sources (Mercury) – The Board accepted for hearing petitioner’s March 14, 2006 proposal to amend the Board’s air pollution control regulations. The Board granted petitioner’s motions to waive copy requirements. The Board denied in-part petitioner’s motion to hold the required hearings in Springfield. The Board will hold at least one hearing in the Chicago area and per the Agency’s request the first hearing will be scheduled in Chicago.
