1) : Standards and Requirements for Potable Water Supply Well Surveys and for Community Relations Activities Performed in Conjunction with Agency Notices of Threats From Contamination

13) Initial Regulatory Flexibility Analysis:

C) Types of Professional skills necessary for compliance: Compliance with this proposed Rule may require the assistance of an attorney, certified public accountant, chemist, and registered professional engineer.

IT SHOULD READ "may require the assistance of an attorney, certified public accountant, chemist, registered professional engineer, and REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL GEOLOGIST".
