RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On August 25, 1983 the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) published notice (48 Fed. Reg. 38728) of the adoption of the following rule to the New Source Performance Standards:


Beverage Can Surface Coating Industry - 40 C.F.R.,  
Subpart WW, (Rule 947).

Since the codification of Chapter 2: Air Pollution, is now imminent, the Board hereby adopts the rule in the present format as Rule 947. However, the Board will include this rule in its submission for codification as Section 230.590 of Title 35: Environmental Protection; Subtitle B: Air Pollution; Chapter I: Pollution Control Board; Subchapter E: Peremptory Rules; Part 230: New Source Performance Standards; Subpart WW.

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Board hereby adopts the above-noted rule as Rule 947 of Part IX of Chapter 2: Air Pollution.
