ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

On February 9, 1978 Petitioner requested a variance from the Water Quality Standard for copper so that it could use copper sulfate as an algicide in its reservoirs from May to September. Rule 203 of Chapter 6: Public Water Supplies of the Board's Rules and Regulations provides that permits for this purpose may be obtained from the Agency. Consequently this Petition is dismissed as the relief requested is unnecessary.
