
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On September 21, 2006, a telephonic status conference was held. Respondent Village of Hinsdale did not appear. The parties represented that they are awaiting receipt of the Board order of September 21, 2006, that addressed the outstanding motion to dismiss.

Complainant represented that it has had a meeting with respondent Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago in an attempt to resolve issues. The complainant also represented that it has a meeting with the Village of Hinsdale on September 25, 2006. Finally, complainant is scheduling a meeting with the Illinois Department of Transportation and DuPage County prior to the next status conference.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on November 1, 2006, at 1:00 p.m.. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. The complainant represented that it will notify the parties and the hearing officer of a call-in number prior to the next telephonic status conference. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


