ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

The Board entered an Order in this matter on October 4, 1978, granting Petitioners a variance from Rules 951, 962 and 604 of Chapter 3. On November 3, 1978, the Agency filed a Motion for Modification of that Order requesting that the Board deny the variance from Rule 951. Rule 951 is the construction permit requirement. The Board agrees with the Agency that a variance from that Rule is unnecessary because grant of a variance from the other Rules should enable Petitioners to obtain a permit. We furthermore agree that participation in the permit process is necessary to ensure protection of the environment. Our grant of a variance from Rule 951 was an oversight, and we hereby modify our Order of October 4 such that a variance from Rule 951 is denied.
