ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Motions to Consolidate filed September 30, 1975 are granted conditional upon United States Steel Corporation filing a waiver with the Board of the 90-day decision period set by statute for an additional 90 days (or more) on or before October 22, 1975 in PCB 73-62. If the waiver is not granted, then consolidation shall not be made.

Motion for Approval Without Hearing, also filed September 30, 1975, is denied. Procedural Rule 333 requires a hearing on a proposed settlement. The Hearing Officer is ordered to set the consolidated matter for hearing if the waiver is timely filed. Said hearing shall be set within 60 days of the date of this Order.
