
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

Pursuant to the November 16, 1995 Board order, Moline/Dutchway Dry Cleaners (Moline) was directed to submit a status report on or before December 8, 1995. Due to an illness, Moline's attorney filed its status report on November 16, 1995. Moline states that it contacted counsel for the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) who agreed that supplemental information to the Agency record was required.
