

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On November 2, 2001, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which E & L Trucking Company (E & L) may appeal an October 2, 2001 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency regarding an application for payment from the underground storage tank fund. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). E & L's facility is located in Cook County. The Board extends the appeal period until February 4, 2002, at the parties' request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Trucking fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
