

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On January 26, 2007, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until April 13, 2007, the time period within which Mikuska Investments, Ltd. (Mikuska) may appeal a December 6, 2006 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2004); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency declined reimbursement for specified costs of corrective action at Mikuska's leaking underground petroleum storage tank facility located at 112 North Larkin Ave. in Joliet, Will County. Because Mikuska failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
