UNOPPOSED MOTION TO FILE CERTIFICATE OF PUBLICATION

Cabot Corporation ("Cabot"), through its attorneys, Seyfarth Shaw LLP, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Admin. Code § 101.500, moves for leave to file the Certificate of Publication, as required by 35 Ill. Admin Code § 140.410. In support of this motion, Cabot states as follows:

1. On April 12, 2007, Cabot filed a Petition for Reissuance of Adjusted Standard ("Petition") from 35 Ill. Admin Code, Part 738, Subpart B for underground injection control ("UIC") Wells Nos. 2 and 3 at its Tuscola, Illinois facility ("Facility").
2. Subsequently, on April 13, 2007, Cabot purchased space to publish notice of the Petition's filing in The Tuscola Review ("Notice"), a weekly secular newspaper of general circulation in the area likely to be affected by the Petition.
3. The Tuscola Review agreed to publish notice of the Petition's filing on Friday, April 20, 2007, well within the fourteen day period prescribed by 35 Ill. Admin Code § 140.408(a).
4. By its own mistake, The Tuscola Review failed to publish the Notice on that date.
5. Upon learning of the newspaper's error, Cabot insisted that The Tuscola Review publish the Notice in its next edition, dated April 27, 2007.
6. The Notice was in fact published in The Tuscola Review on April 27, 2007, the

2. fifteenth day after Cabot filed the Petition.

7. The substance of the Notice complies with the requirements of 35 Ill. Admin Code § 104.408(b).

8. In light of these circumstances, Cabot moves for leave to file the attached Certification of Publication and relief from the requirement that the Notice have been published within fourteen days of the Petition's filing.

9. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency does not oppose this motion.

WHEREFORE, Cabot Corporation respectfully requests that the Board grant it leave to file the attached Certificate of Publication and relief from the requirement that the Notice have been published within fourteen days of the Petition's filing.

NOTICE OF PETITION BY CABOT CORPORATION FOR REISSUANCE OF AN ADJUSTED STAND- DARD BEFORE THE ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD

On April 12, 2007, Cabot Corporation (hereafter "Cabot") filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board (hereafter the "Board") a Petition for Reissuance of Adjusted Standard from the requirements of 35 Ill. Admin. Code Part 738, Subpart B (Docket No. AS 07-05). Cabot is located on Route 36 near Tuscola, Illinois. Cabot manufactures fumed metal oxides, including fumed silica (SiO₂), for use in a variety of products. As part

of its operation, Cabot generates hazardous wastes that are injected into on-site underground injection control ("UIC") wells. Through the Petition, Cabot is requesting reissuance of the "no migration exemption" the Board previously issued on March 7, 1996. If granted, the Petition will allow Cabot to continue to dispose of restricted wastes in Wells Nos. 2 and 3 through December 31, 2027. Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described adjusted standard proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the adjusted standard proceeding, as found in this notice, and must be mailed to the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution

Control Board, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 41-500, Chicago, Illinois




