ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On June 11, 2007, the Board received a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Russell Oil Company, Inc. (Russell) may appeal a May 9, 2007 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). According to the joint notice, Russell received the Agency determination on May 11, 2007. The joint request was therefore timely filed. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b)(2), 105.406. The Agency's determination concerns Russell's leaking underground storage tank site located at 309 DeYoung Street Facility #7-010002 in Williamson County. In the determination, the Agency accepted Russell's Corrective Action Plan but modified the budget.

The Board extends the appeal period until September 13, 2007, as the parties request, based on the May 11, 2007 decision receipt date. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Russell fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
