NOW COMES the Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by and through its attorneys, and requests leave to add a supporting exhibit to the Illinois EPA's Motion for Reconsideration recently filed with the Board in the above-captioned matter. In support thereof, the Respondent states the following:

- 1. On June 25, 2007, the Illinois EPA electronically filed a Motion for Reconsideration (hereinafter "Motion") with the Board pertaining to an earlier May 17, 2007, order. In that Motion, the Illinois EPA referred to a document entitled "Report of the Attorney General's Task Force on Environmental Legal Resources (1992)" (hereinafter "Attorney General's Task Force Report"). The document was also previously cited in one of the objections received by the Board concerning the fast-track proposal.
 - 2. On or about June 29, 2007, the undersigned attorney received a phone call

from one of the attorneys now representing a consortium of natural gas suppliers. The attorney requested assistance from the Illinois EPA in locating a copy of the Attorney General's Task Force Report. The undersigned attorney provided the requesting attorney a facsimile copy of relevant portions of the document on that same date and, further, represented that a complete copy of the document would be made with the Board and other interested parties.

3. For the convenience of the Board and other interested parties, the Illinois EPA herewith seeks leave to supplement its earlier Motion for Reconsideration with a copy of the above-referenced document. The Attorney General's Task Force Report, attached hereto, appears in the same form as the copy currently maintained by the Illinois EPA in its public library at the Springfield, Illinois headquarters.

4. No hardship or prejudice will occur to any interested person associated with this rulemaking.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests that the Board grant leave to supplement the Illinois EPA's prior Motion for Reconsideration with a copy of the aforementioned exhibit or, in the alterative, provide such relief as may be just and appropriate.
