## **HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On May 25, 2007, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a proposal under the general rulemaking provisions of Section 27 of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/27 (2006)). The rulemaking proposal was submitted pursuant to P. A. 94-849, which added Section 13.6 to the Act (415 ILCS 5/13.6 (2006)). Section 13.6 of the Act requires that the Agency propose rules to the Board "prescribing standards for detecting and

reporting unpermitted releases of radionuclides." 415 ILCS 5/13.6 (2006). On June 21, 2007, the Board accepted this proposal for hearing.

Prior to the hearing, the Agency must file copies of the reports listed in the proposal that the Agency relied upon in developing the proposal. The proposal lists these documents and states where the public can find copies; however for the purposes of the Board's record, those reports must be filed with the Board.

The Board will hold at least two hearings in this matter. Both hearings will be conducted to allow the Agency and all other interested persons the opportunity to present testimony on the proposed rules. The order of the first hearing will be:

1. Opening statements;

- 2. Prefiled testimony by the Agency and questions of the Agency;
- 3. Prefiled testimony of interested persons.

The order of the second hearing will be determined at the beginning of the second hearing.

The "Notice List" is the list of interested persons who wish to receive only the Board's opinions and orders and hearing officer orders in this proceeding. The "Service List" is persons who wish to participate in the proceeding and receive all prefiled testimony and to be participants of record. To be placed on either the "Notice List" or the "Service List" contact the hearing officer at the address or phone number below.

Persons who plan to testify must prefile their testimony. Persons wishing to testify at September 5, 2007 hearing shall prefile testimony by August 24, 2007. That testimony will be available either on the Board's web page at <a href="https://www.ipcb.state.il.us">www.ipcb.state.il.us</a> or by contacting the hearing officer. The prefiling deadline for the second hearing will be established at the close of the first hearing.
