JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2004).

FACTS

1. That Charles Stuller ("Respondent") is the present owner of a facility located at 306 Rice Street, Wilsonville, Macoupin County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Wilsonville/Stuller.
2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1171205006.
3. That Respondent has owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
4. That on June 4, 2007, Mark Weber of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Springfield Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Mark Weber during the course of his June 4, 2007 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2004).

- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3)(2004).

- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in Deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris: or Clean Construction or Demolition Debris a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2004).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2004), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than August 30, 2007, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2004), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2004), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2004). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

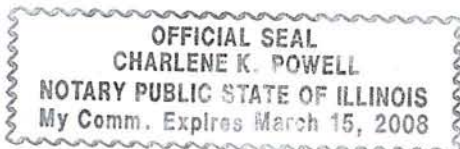

On June 4, 2007 Mark Weber Division of Land Pollution Control/Field Operations Section (DLPC/FOS) - Springfield Regional Office (SRO) conducted a re-inspection of the Stuller site in Macoupin County. More specifically the site is located at 306 Rice Street in Wilsonville, Illinois. The initial site inspection was conducted by the SRO on March 8, 2007. The initial inspection was conducted as a result of a complaint of on-site demolition debris and waste generated as a result of an October 2006 fire.

June 4, 2007 Re-Inspection

The Illinois EPA re-inspection of the Stuller site took place between approximately 0950 and 1020 on June 4, 2007. The temperature was approximately 65° F. It was mostly sunny with a 20 mile per hour west wind. Soil conditions were wet due to recent rains. Mr. Charles Stuller, the current property owner according to a 2004 deed obtained from the Macoupin County Recorder's Office, was not present during the re-inspection.

Wastes observed during the June 4, 2007 Illinois EPA re-inspection were the same as those observed during the March 8, 2007 site inspection. These wastes include mixed metals, dimensional lumber, brick, vinyl siding, wire, cement block, white goods, insulation, asphalt shingles, and paper. Most of these wastes were generated as a result of the fire. At least 15 used tires are located in two on-site storage sheds as well. Illinois EPA inspectors also identified at least twelve 55-gallon drums and 5-gallon buckets at various locations throughout the site. None of the containers were marked or placarded. An empty above ground storage tank (AST) was observed as well.

The site appeared virtually untouched since the initial site inspection. As noted above, all of the illegally dumped waste remains on-site. On April 11, 2007 the Illinois EPA SRO sent an Administrative Citation Warning Notification (ACWN) to Mr. Stuller. To date Mr. Stuller has not provided the SRO with a response as per the conditions of the ACWN.

Photograph #1 provides a view of the burned out residence from Rice Street.

Photograph #2 shows the southern portion of the Stuller property as seen from Rice Street.

Photograph #3 is of the burned out remains of the home at 306 Rice Street looking in to the basement. Brick, dimensional lumber, mixed metals, and insulation are visible.

Photograph #4 depicts a drum containing assorted solid waste, two partially burned doors, dimensional lumber, and the remains of a burned tire.

Photograph #5 provides another view of the remains of the burned out residence at 306 Rice Street.

Photograph #6 shows 55-gallon drums (contents unknown), mixed metals, dimensional lumber, plastics, and 5 gallon buckets (contents unknown) open dumped at the Stuller property.

Photograph #7 provides a view of the burned out remains of 306 Rice Street from the back yard.

Photograph #8 is of 55-gallon drums located behind the burned out residence. The contents of the drums are unknown. Some appear to contain rock and/or soil.

Photograph #9 is of an inactive open burn area located in the back yard of the former residence. This does not appear to be a result of the residential fire.

Photograph #10 depicts one of the two sheds located on-site that were not affected by the fire. The shed, located near the east property line, contains at least 10 used tires.

The June 4, 2007 re-inspection was conducted in order to determine if progress had been made on-site in voluntarily returning to compliance. All violations of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act cited in the April 11, 2007 ACWN were found to still exist at the Stuller site. These violations include Sections: 9(a), 9(c), 21(a), 21(d)(1), 21(d)(2), 21(e), 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), 21(p)(7), 55(a)(1), and 55(a)(2). Apparent violations of the Regulations, 35 IAC include Sections 722.111, 808.121 and 812.101. Refer to the attached Open Dump Checklist for additional information.
