ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D.Dumelle):

On December 3, 1981, the Board entered a final Order in R76-21: Amendments to Chapter 3: Water Pollution (Effluent Standards) which, inter alia, relaxed the applicable mercury discharge standards.

Accordingly, the proposed site-specific regulatory amendment originally requested by the Textile Maintenance Institute in R79-1 appears to be no longer necessary. Thus, the regulatory proceeding in R79-1 is hereby dismissed as moot.
