AC 08-008 <u>IEPA v. James and Mildred Taviner</u> – The Board accepted an administrative citation against these Williamson County respondents.

AC 08-009 <u>IEPA v. Gene and Elena Greenwood</u> – The Board accepted an administrative citation against these Calhoun County respondents.

R08-009 In The Matter of: Water Quality Standards and Effluent Limitations for the Chicago Area Waterway System and the Lower Des Plaines River: Proposed Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 301, 302, 303 and 304 – The Board accepted for hearing the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's October 26, 2007 proposal to amend the Board's water pollution control regulations.
